Our Facilities and Session Times

The Town of Victoria Park owns and maintains lease agreements with our fellow co-tenants, the Toy Library and the Carlisle/Lathlain Child Health Nurse. We share the communal areas including the kitchen, toilets and outside space.

Session times are flexible but generally morning sessions will take place between 9-11:30 pm, midday sessions from 12-2 and afternoon sessions from 2.30- 5. Day leaders should liaise with the Membership Coordinator if they change the usual time they open or leave for insurance purposes.

Membership fees

How It Works

- Full Family Membership: \$150 per annum
- Discounts apply for concession card holders and early payments (see below).
- Membership typically runs from 1 February – 31 January. Though this year it has been delayed due to changes in the Playgroup WA payment of insurance. So in 2025 it will run from 1 March - 31 January
- Members joining partway through the year may pay a pro-rata fee,



determined by the Treasurer.

Important Update for 2025

From 2025 onwards, all Playgroup WA (PGWA) insurance fees must be paid directly to PGWA before joining Lathlain Playgroup.

These guidelines serve us well in making playgroup a safe and inclusive environment:

1. Adults are responsible for the safety and supervision of the children they bring.
2. Every child has a right to safe and fair play.
3. Playgroup is a “no hurting” zone.
4. Playgroup is a smoke free environment.
5. All members are valued and respected.
6. All families are welcome.
7. We are a Sun Smart playgroup.
8. Everyone helps with the workload and is involved in setting up and cleaning of playgroup.

Busy Bees

When you complete the membership forms you would have been asked to nominate for one of our five busy bee sessions. These sessions help us to keep our playgroup in tip top shape. These sessions typically take 1.5 to 2 hours. You will be sent an email to remind you of the busy bee session. Light refreshments are provided.

Please note, in 2025 due to feedback we have introduced a Busy Bee Opt-Out fee, if for some reason you are unable to make any busy bees, we ask that you please pay \$50 towards cleaning and maintenance for the year.

Looking after our playgroup

Groups will be allocated a cleaning task in addition to the regular list of cleaning duties to be completed by each group. This is important to maintain an adequate level of hygiene for all members, to be respectful of other sessions and to ensure our toys and equipment are looked after.

General Meetings

We hold four general meetings per year plus an Annual General Meeting. The Day Leader or nominated representative from each session is required to attend in order to have appropriate representation to pass motions. All members are welcome to attend.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I bring friends and relatives to playgroup?

It's best to check with your day leader as a courtesy. You may bring visitors from time to time, or share 'parent duties' with another person such as a grandparent. Visitors are asked to sign in at the bottom of the sign in sheet for that session.

Can I bring my own food?

Yes definitely, please do! Due to members with severe allergies, we ask that no nuts or nut products are brought into playgroup. We also do not permit whole egg



or products containing a significant amount of eggs in any session.

Cakes, biscuits with egg is permitted but we ask that all food carefully cleaned away at the end of each session. Sessions that have children attending with severe allergies may adopt further restrictions.

Please note we may revise this list in accordance with members' needs. **Please let us know if your child has any life threatening allergies.**

Can I hire playgroup for birthday parties?

Yes! We take bookings for members only on Saturday afternoons from 12pm-5pm and Sundays between 9am and 5pm. The hire fee is \$120. Please email our events coordinator at lathlainplaygroup.events@gmail.com

What is involved in the busy bees?

They usually take between 1.5-2hrs. At least two representatives per group is needed to carried out thorough clean of the toys or other general maintenance as required. You would have selected a date as part of your membership form. We will send out reminders.

Do I have to attend general meetings? How often are they?

We have four general meetings each year and our Annual General Meeting which is held in January. Day leaders and Committee members are asked to attend as required by our constitution to pass decisions. Other members may attend, or represent the day leader if they are unable to. Refer to the calendar posted around the playgroup.
